

CULTURE & HISTORY

Located one hour north of Dallas and sitting just 10 minutes south of Lake Texoma, Denison, TX is the perfect destination. Known as the gateway city, Denison was founded in 1872 in conjunction with the Missouri-Kansas-Texas Railroad and was the entry point of the first non-Texas based railroad. You can visit the historic Katy Depot's Red River Railroad Museum or reserve the space for private events and weddings.

Denison is also the birthplace of President Dwight D. Eisenhower. His home has been restored and is open daily to the public for tours.

Viticulturalist, TV Munson, moved to Denison in 1876 and because of the rootstock he developed here, he saved the European wine industry from devastation. Today, Cognac, France and Denison are known as sister cities. TV Munson's legacy continues through the Viticulture & Enology program at Grayson College.


